2. Purpose and Legal Basis for Data Processing

We process personal data strictly for the following purposes:

Session management – Ensuring users stay logged in and restoring their last session when re-entering the platform.

Error detection – Identifying unintentional logouts and system issues.

User experience improvement – Storing game interactions to provide a seamless gaming & learning experience.

We do **not** use your data for advertising or commercial purposes.

The legal basis for processing your data is Art. 6(1)(e) GDPR (public interest in education).

3. Data Collected

When using our platform, we may collect the following data:

User session data (login status, session expiration)
Error logs (e.g., system crashes or unintended logouts)
Game interactions (for a seamless experience)

We do **not** collect personally identifiable information (PII) beyond what is technically necessary for platform functionality.

4. Data Retention

Session and interaction data are stored **only as long as necessary** for their intended purpose.

Error logs are retained for debugging purposes.

No data is stored beyond these limits unless legally required.

5. Data Security & Access

We implement technical and organizational measures to protect your data from unauthorized access. Only **authorized university Graveler Project Team personnel** can access tracking logs when necessary.

6. Your Rights as a User

Under GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your data:

Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR) – Request information on what data we store about you.

Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR) – Correct inaccurate data.

Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR) – Request deletion of your data, where legally applicable.

Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR) – Request limited processing under certain conditions.

Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR) – Object to data processing based on public interest grounds.

Right to lodge a complaint – File a complaint with the data protection authority if you believe your rights have been violated.
